

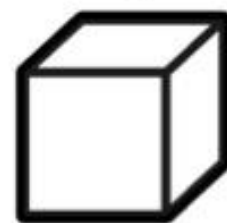
How to Play

Materials:

Dice/Cube labeled with sight words
Dry erase markers or vis-à-vis markers
Roll & Write worksheet
Pencil, pens, or markers

Set Up & Play:

Label your dice/cube with the sight words your student needs to review.
